English

In English we will be focusing on recounts. We will be looking at a range of texts including letters, biographies and autobiographies. The students will be writing non-chronological reports about a chosen European country.

Mathematics

In maths this term we will investigate number, probability, 2D and 3D shapes, fractions, angles, position and direction. We will also be focussing on the 7 times table.

Science

This term we will focus on the study of energy, light and electric circuits. We will explore the different types of energy, light as well as the reflection of light, then we will explore the properties of conductors and insulators and how to make a complete circuit.

This year, Year 4 will explore the continent of Europe and the countries within. Using our focus on the geography of Europe, as well as other countries throughout the world, students will compare the physical and human landscapes of various countries. Our science unit on energy will "shed some light on different types of energy".

Art

We will learn about landscape art and explore different mixed media artmaking processes.

Music

This term we will explore the keyboard instruments and build practical skills. Children will sing a range of new songs.

Computing

Children will learn how to use PowerPoint, Canva and Word to create their P.B.L Projects.

Spanish

This term students will learn the numbers from 1 to 15, talk about their families, and discover the definite article and genders in Spanish.

PSHE

We will focus on growth mindset, jobs, skills, and challenging stereotypes.

German

We will learn about cloths, our room and numbers in a creative and fun way.

Slovak/SAL

During this term main theme is selected words after both consonants /p, r, s, v/ Pupils acquire theoretical knowledge and linguistic rules, which they apply when solving various tasks. There is an intense focus on working with text and presenting pupils' work. In literature lessons, reading comprehension, identification of information given in text and formulation of questions are taught. At the end of January, we will have class and school rounds of the recitation competition Hviezdoslavov Kubin.

Physical Education
