Science

We will begin with learning about materials and understanding the States of Matter. We will also look at mixtures and how they can be separated. For the second half of the term, we will focus on forces and energy including friction, gravity and magnetism.

Mathematics

We will begin the year by covering numbers to 1000, with a focus on place value, odd and even numbers, and counting in 10s and 100s. We will then move onto addition and subtraction of 2- digit numbers using mental strategies, followed by a unit on 2D and 3D shapes.
